☐ BUDGET

Establish a budget for your project and secure financing.

☐ REQUIREMENTS

Determine if city permits will be required. This is done by researching municipal bylaws and BC building code requirements. If you prefer, 360 does provide permit application consulting services. It is also important to confirm the age of your building. If it was built prior to 1990, it will need to be tested for asbestos. If present, it will have to be safely removed. All services we provide.

☐ ACCESS

Decide if it is realistic to live at home during the renovation. Should our work prohibit use of the kitchen or bathroom, it may be better to arrange alternate accommodation. Our team will also require access to your home. This can be done by using a lockbox or in person at specified times.

☐ TIMELINE

Be sure to plan well in advance for your project and give us your estimated timeline. We'll ensure ample time is allocated for each step in the renovation process.



Review the checklist and call to schedule an appointment.



Meet your Project Manager at the 360 Building Centre showroom. Our team will confirm the project layout, assist with permit applications, and help you select materials, products, appliances, fixtures and finishes.



Our Project Estimator will visit your space to take photos and measurements.



You will receive a final cost estimate within 3-5 days of the site visit.



You will have 14 days to make any modifications and approve the estimate.



Once you approve and sign the estimate, a 50% deposit payment is due.



Start date and timeline are scheduled.



On start date: meet with Site Manager to confirm project details. "Before" photos are taken.



Site Manager schedules and completes city permit inspections as required.



You will be required to approve any Change Orders (if applicable)



25% progress draw is due. You will receive regular budget and timeline updates.



Upon completion: Final walk-through and sign-off. "After" photos are taken. Final 25% payment is due.
